## Swimming Pool Usage Guidance

- 1. Purchase a ticket at the vending machine. One ticket is required per person.
  - ★General admission (adults): 610 yen / ★Children below high school age: 300 yen
  - ★Adults aged 60 and over: 300 yen
- 2. Submit your ticket to the staff at the reception counter.
- 3. You will also be asked to write down your name, phone number on the user board.
- 4. You will receive a locker key. Please return the key when leaving the facility.
- 5. Remove your shoes on the red mat and place them in the shoe cabinet.
- 6. Change into your swimwear in the locker room. Swimming caps are required in the pool.
  - Note: Jewelry is not allowed. Tattoos must be fully covered and not visible to others.

- 7. Shower thoroughly and remove any cosmetics before entering the pool.
- 8. Eating, drinking, and bringing glass items into the pool area are prohibited.

## < Note >

- 1. Swimwear is not sold at the facility, so please bring your own.
- 2. Swimming caps (rental: 100 yen / purchase: 700 yen), goggles (rental: 100 yen / purchase: 1,980 yen), and swim rings (rental only: 100 yen) are available for rent or purchase.
- 3. Children who still wear diapers are not permitted to enter the pool.
- 4. Children under elementary school age must be accompanied in the pool by a guardian who is a high school student or older, wearing swimwear, and within arm's reach at all times.
- 5. Please note that the 25-meter pool is divided into designated lanes: walking-only lanes, swimming-only lanes, reserved lanes, and free-use lanes.
- 6. For your safety, please do NOT dive into the pool, run on the pool deck, or hold onto the lane ropes.
